GEORGIA AND THE GEORGIAN LANGUAGE

Georgia is a country in the Caucasus region, known since ancient times as the land of the Golden Fleece. It ranges from the Great Caucasus mountains to the subtropical Black Sea coast.

In the post-Soviet period Georgia has obtained new strategic significance. Regional great powers – Russia and Turkey – compete for political influence in the region. New external actors, primarily the EU and the USA, show an increased interest and presence in the region.

GEORGIAN LANGUAGE AND SCRIPT

Georgian has about 4 million speakers. It is a South Caucasian (Kartvelian) language that has a unique script which dates back to the 5th century AD.



GEORGIAN ONLINE

The Georgian language course is offered exclusively online with instruction in English. It gives an introduction to Georgian language and culture, as well as basic knowledge of the grammar and vocabulary. All the necessary course material is available online to registered students.

Students from about thirty countries all around the world have followed the course, which has been offered since 2004.
